Why TENx10 is needed

For generations, Jesus' invitation has been clear: **"Follow me."** While this invitation and the mission of the church have not changed over the last 2,000 years, fewer and fewer young people are responding with "yes." It's estimated that each year, **1 million young people who were disciplined as teenagers will walk away from the church—and from the full, abundant life of Jesus.**

The TENx10 Collaboration believes we're at a tipping point. Now is the time for Christ-followers to reprioritize and rethink how we disciple young people.

Motivated by John 17:20-23, dozens of Christian leaders and ministry organizations have prayed for two years about how God can use the unity of the body of Christ to accomplish what we could not achieve on our own.

Energized by these hopes, **a collaborative team is guiding TENx10** comprised of leaders from the Fuller Youth Institute, Life.Church, the National Federation for Catholic Youth Ministry, Orange, Pinetops Foundation, and the Urban Youth Workers Institute. More broadly, TENx10 is made possible because of the support and involvement of 21 diverse denominations and over 20 more partners who want to collaborate to see young people changed by Christ to change our world.

The mission of TENx10

The mission of TENx10 is to help faith matter more for 10 million teenagers in the next 10 years--in the spirit of John 10:10. TENx10 is prayerfully accomplishing that mission through two national goals.

- ✘ **Goal #1:** To spread a **clear discipleship strategy** of empowered leaders and caring Christian adults focused on teenagers' identity, belonging, and purpose, and
- ✘ **Goal #2:** To provide the **comprehensive support** leaders need to implement that strategy through collaboration with leading ministry organizations.

Training Options

As a discipleship hub, TENx10 strives to offer you the strategy, tools, training, and support you need to impact even more young people.

To serve your unique needs, we've developed three different training options that start in August 2021. While all of them build on the foundation of our premier online training, you can choose the plan that offers the coaching and time investment that works best for you and your ministry. Who should participate in the TENx10 training?

As you contemplate which TENx10 training option is best for you, we encourage you to think about your best team to participate. In addition to a youth leader, we strongly recommend:

- ✘ **A senior leader** (lead pastor, priest, ministry leader), because TENx10’s mission of making faith matter more for 10 million youth in the next 10 years requires systemic changes within the church or ministry
- ✘ **Key volunteers, a parent of a teenager or other adults in the ministry** who are passionate about the discipleship of young people.

Note: You may do the self-guided digital training alone, though in all cases working through the TENx10 training with others in your ministry will make it even more effective.
